✓	Stewardship Opportunity	Description*
	Altar Server	Assists the priests and deacons by serving on the altar in a prayerful manner during Mass or other liturgical celebrations.
	Bereavement Committee	Offers assistance and support to grieving parishioners through phone calls, visits, etc. and assists at funerals as needed.
	Bible Study Group	Reads, studies, and discusses selections from the Bible.
	Choir	Enhances liturgical texts and inspires the congregation to more fully participate via song. The choir has weekly rehearsals on Tuesday evenings and sings for Saturday Vigil Masses and Holydays. Music reading skills are helpful but not required.
	Extraordinary Minister of the Eucharist	Assists the Priest and deacons by distributing Holy Communion.
	Greeter	Welcomes all who enter the church for Mass and other liturgical celebrations.
	Lector	Proclaims God's Word at Mass and other liturgical celebrations.
	Parish Activities Group (PAG)	Serves the parish and community by planning social & fellowship activities and fundraisers.
	Seniors Group	Serves the parish seniors through monthly meetings (first Wednesday of each month, with finger foods and bingo) and other fellowship and faith events.
	Usher/Collector	Walks around the church to take up offertory collections from parishioners at Mass and other liturgical celebrations.
	Education Committee (A Mission of the Parish Pastoral Council)	Provides educational programs to parishioners to promote adult and youth faith formation through the study of our Catholic faith, traditions, and practices. Programs include bible study, RCIA, lectures, etc.
	Evangelization Committee (A Mission of the Parish Pastoral Council)	Reaches out to our families, friends, and neighbors, and welcomes them back to their faith or introduces them to our parish. Demonstrates the living presence of Jesus Christ through our love, prayer, and service.
	Liturgy & Worship Committee (A Mission of the Parish Pastoral Council)	Nourishes and gives direction to the liturgical and worship elements of the parish such as altar servers, lectors, choir, devotions, etc.
	Pastoral Ministry Committee (A Mission of the Parish Pastoral Council)	Offers support to parishioners who cannot attend Mass or participate in parish activities, whether they are home-bound or in nursing/assisted living facilities. Our mission is to connect with these members and keep them involved in parish life by visits and engaging in conversation.
	St. Vincent de Paul Society – Social Concerns Committee (A Mission of the Parish Pastoral Council)	Provides support in an understanding, gentle, and nonjudgmental manner to our parishioners and those within our parish territory. The two key programs of our SVDP society are the Food Pantry and the Parishioner Program.
